The objective of the event was to present the outputs and results of the project and engage the target groups with the resources that were developed during the project. During the meeting a key note speaker and young business owner presented the journey of his start-up and the different stages that went through. Then an open discussion session followed, with all partners presenting the situation of climate change in their country. With the finalization of the presentations, the participants were involved in discussions related to climate change and how the GoGreen resources can be used to their personal and professional life. The participants were very enthusiastic about the resources and that everything is available for free on the eLearning platform. The VET educators commented that the material will definitely be useful for their trainings with business owners.
